Parent Open Mornings- on Tuesday 30th January and Friday 2nd February, from 9am-9.30am, we are inviting parents in to school to come and look at your child's learning with them. For children in Year 2-Year 6, you will have the opportunity to meet with your child(ren) in the school hall and they will show you their books and talk to you about the learning they have enjoyed so far this year and the work that they are proud of. If you have more than one child, you can sit as a family and look through their work together. For children in Reception and Year 1, you will have the opportunity to watch the children take part in a short learning input and then you will be able to join them in learning in the provision areas (Reception) and look at their books in the hall











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(Year 1). If you have a child in Reception or Year 1 and children in other year groups, we would recommend you going into Reception/Year 1 initially and then going into the hall to meet with your other child(ren). If you have children in both Reception and Year 1, you will be able to move between the two classrooms.

Year 6 SATs Information evening- on Monday 5th February at 5pm we are holding a meeting to share information regarding the Year 6 SATS. It has been on the school calendar for Year 2 as well, but from this year, the Year 2 SATs are no longer statutory. It is therefore not necessary to meet with Year 2 parents. The children in Year 2 will still do assessments in the Summer Term to support teacher judgements, but this is normal part of practice in all year groups and the children are used to doing termly assessments, so it will not be anything new for them.

Measles Outbreaks-please see the attached guidance for parents which we have been asked to circulate, as in other areas of the country there have been outbreaks of measles and there is a concern that these outbreaks will spread to other areas of the country.
